Town Takes First Steps in Village Accessibility Project

Commuters and residents will soon have improved access to Apple Valley's historic downtown district after the Town of Apple Valley reconstructs John Glenn Road. At the June 12 meeting, the Town Council approved a solicitation for bids to pave the street, and install curb, gutter, and sidewalk along the east side of the road.

A cooperative effort between the Town of Apple Valley and the Village Property and Business Improvement District (PBID), the Apple Valley Village Accessibility Project will allow the Town to accept the private road into the Town's street system and provide maintenance.

The PBID pledged \$250,000 to pave and reconstruct the road with the Town matching \$250,000 in Local Transportation Funds for curb, gutter and sidewalk - creating an ADA accessible path to Outer Highway 18 South from Navajo, along Powhatan and John Glenn Roads by the end of 2018.

"We are connecting people to services," said Mayor Art Bishop. "It will be much easier for cars and pedestrians to get to places like the Apple Valley Post Office, James Woody Community Park, the Victor Valley Transit Authority Bus Transfer Station on Quinnault Road and, of course, the Village Business District."
