PBID Renewal

It's PBID renewal time again!

The Village PBID (Property & Business Improvement District) was established for 5 years in 2007 and renewed in 2012 for 5 more years as a means for Village property owners to jointly manage and fund needed property and business related programs and improvements within the Village business district. PBIDs such as the one in the Village have been successfully set up and renewed again and again in over 200 business districts throughout California.

Over the past 9 years, the Village PBID has specifically helped fund supplemental Sheriff's Department security, Highway 18 center median landscaping, a colorful seasonal banner program along Highway 18, a storefront and property improvement rebate program, kiosk directory signs along Highway 18, a Village website, advertising/media exposure and a Village newsletter. It is noteworthy to mention that the Village PBID Association was able to secure additional matching Town and State grant funds that provided a 2:1 leverage of property owner assessment revenues for the Highway 18 median island beautification project.




The PBID must now be renewed in order to continue funding these services and additional new improvements throughout the Village. The renewal will not happen, though, without a new vote by Village property owners preceded by a new petition campaign. If signed petitions are gathered from enough Village owners who represent a majority (over 50%) of the assessment funds to be collected in the PBID, all Village property owners will then be given the opportunity to "vote" again on the renewed PBID.

The PBID petition and balloting phases will take place over the next 4-8 months as the PBID Association Board considers boundaries, projects, programs, costs and assessment funding levels. Additional updates will be provided in this newsletter as well as direct mailings to Village property owners. Thank you for your continued support!
