PAVING PROJECT

As part of the Town of Apple Valley's 2019 resurfacing project, Powhatan Road, Quinnault Road, Headquarters Drive and both north and south of Outer Highway 18 will be resurfaced inside The Village. The town-wide project's main focus will be to extend the life of several Victor Valley Transit Authority (VVTA) bus routes and reduce the likelihood of potholes.
